
# 1. INTRODUCTION


# 1.1 Location Map of the Production Unit

#### 4. AUDIT METHOD AND PROGRAMME

The audit was conducted in 1 day, involving 2 mandays in Unistate Sea Food (Sabah) Estate. The audit covers documentation review for internal procedures, management system, field inspection as well as identification of any significant issues for both environment or social issues and also the peer reviewer process as per ACB-OPMC-3. The 30 days of stakeholder consultation prior to the audit date as required by ACB-OPMC -4.

The audit evidence obtained was based on a sample of the information; thereby introducing an element of uncertainty. The methodology for objective evidence collection included physical site inspection, observation of tasks and processes, interview with workers, families and stakeholders, documentation review and monitoring data.

# 5. ASSESSMENT FINDINGS


